Tour begins and ends at Cape Town International Airport

Tues 03-Sep—Arrive Cape Town

Spend two nights in the Bantry Bay Suite Hotel, enjoy dinner at Cape Town's Waterfront and enjoy a city tour that includes the Bokaap, Table Mountain and Kirstenbosch Gardens



Thurs 05-Sep—Head to McGregor (4 nights)

Stop off on the way before checking into selected accommodation in the village and registering for the Ride2Nowhere.

Mon 09-Sep—Aquila Private Game Reserve

Travel through the Hex River Valley to the Karoo. Enjoy an afternoon game drive and dinner with a second early morning game drive



Mon 09-Sep—Citrusdal (2 nights)

Take a main or back route routes to follow take you through the historic Cape Dutch town of Tulbagh, and then either via Ceres and Mitchell's Pass or through the lovely town of Riebeeck West. Cycle The Loop, walk to the Maltese cross and swim in rock pools. Visit the Staatsaal Caves and San Rock art; buy *velskoene* in Wuppertal.



Thurs 12-Sep— Clanwilliam (1 night)

Go in search of spring flowers around Niewoudtville; visit the Hantam Botanical Gardens—the second largest Quiver Tree forest on earth; take Van Rhyns Pass and taste at Klawer.

Friday 13-Sept: Paternoster (2 nights)

Paternoster is the base for visits to the Elandsberg Rooibos Tea estate and Lamberts Bay, home to one of the largest Cape Gannet colonies, and a visit to Darling for wine and beer tastings is another must-do.



Mon 16-Sep—Depart Cape Town - return home
